- **Use Appropriate Drill Bits and Speed** Select a drill bit slightly smaller than the required hole diameter. Control the drilling speed to prevent overheating, which can damage the enclosure or create sparks .
- **Protect Internal Components** Avoid damaging internal electrical components by using protective shims or non-metallic drill bits. Ensure debris does not accumulate inside the box, as it can affect performance .
