

How to dry power fiber optic cables

Drying Techniques for Fiber Optic Cables

1. Use Lint-Free Pads or Swabs: After wet cleaning with 99% reagent-grade isopropyl alcohol (IPA), immediately wipe the connector end with a dry, lint-free pad or swab to remove any remaining moisture. This prevents residue buildup and ensures the ferrule is completely dry before insertion . 2. One-Click or Cassette Cleaners: For quick drying and cleaning, dry cleaning tools such as one-click cleaners (e.g., Cletop® or OptiClean®) or reel-based cassette cleaners can sweep away dust and moisture simultaneously. These tools are designed to gently lift debris and absorb residual liquid without scratching the fiber end . 3. Air Drying with Caution: If using compressed air, ensure it is dry and free of propellant residue. Hold the can upright and spray for 3-5 seconds to expel any liquid propellant before directing it at the connector. Avoid using standard canned air that may leave moisture or residue . 4. Inspection After Drying: Always inspect the fiber end with a fiber optic microscope or inspection probe (200x magnification recommended) to confirm it is free of moisture, dust, or scratches. Even tiny droplets can cause signal loss or increased reflectance .

Best Practices

- Keep dust caps on connectors when not in use to prevent moisture and dust accumulation .
- Avoid cotton swabs or regular cloths, as they can leave fibers or residues that attract moisture .
