Preparation and Tray Inspection

Cable Routing and Organization

- Classify cables by type and function (power, signal, control) and assign zones within the tray to prevent interference .
- Lay cables in an organized manner, avoiding excessive bending or twisting. Maintain a minimum bend radius as specified by the cable manufacturer .
- Use tiered arrangements for multi-level trays, placing critical or heat-generating cables in accessible layers with adequate ventilation .
