

How to ground the flexible wire in the distribution box

4. Connect to the Grounding Bar: Attach the stripped end of the wire to the grounding bar using a screw terminal. Tighten the screw firmly to ensure a solid mechanical and electrical connection. For devices inside the box, you can use pigtails or ground clips to connect each component to the grounding bar .
5. Bond to the Main Ground: Ensure the grounding bar is connected to the main grounding system, such as a grounding rod or central grounding point. This may involve connecting the bar to a metal mounting plate or directly to a buried ground rod .
6. Verify Grounding: Use a voltmeter or ground resistance tester to measure the resistance between the distribution box and the main ground. The resistance should meet safety standards (typically below 25 ohms for building installations) to ensure effective grounding .
