

How to identify the model of a telecommunications fiber optic cable

- The print legend often includes abbreviations like SM (9/125) for single-mode or MMF (50/125) for multimode, indicating core and cladding diameters .
- Fiber count is typically printed as a number, e.g., 864F means 864 fibers .

Step 3: Inspect Connectors

The type of connector can provide clues about the cable's intended use:

- LC - small form-factor connector
