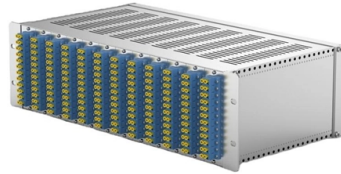


How to lay BTZ cables in cable trays

Secure the tray using appropriate brackets and supports, spaced typically 1.5 to 3 meters apart depending on tray type and load. Align trays straight and level, using connectors and fittings to maintain continuity. For long runs, consider using cable tray rollers to facilitate smooth cable laying and prevent kinks .
