

How to lay fiber optic cables in the field

Planning and Site Survey

Before any physical work, conduct a comprehensive site survey to determine the optimal cable route. Consider terrain, soil conditions, existing utilities, and potential obstacles like roads, rivers, or rock formations. Obtain all necessary permits and right-of-way approvals. Define clear access points and avoid tight bends or unnecessary detours to minimize future maintenance challenges and ensure compliance with the cable's minimum bend radius and maximum pulling tension specifications .

Trenching and Conduit Placement

For underground installations, dig trenches to the required depth, typically 18-36 inches, depending on soil type, local regulations, and environmental factors. Urban areas may require shallower trenches (12-24 inches), while rural or high-traffic areas may need deeper burial to prevent damage from machinery . Place HDPE or PVC conduits in the trench to protect the fiber and facilitate future upgrades. Conduits may include pre-installed innerducts with pulling tape to simplify cable installation . In some cases, directional boring can be used to cross streets or sidewalks without disturbing the surface .
