Main Principles of Circuit Numbering

In a distribution box, each circuit is assigned a unique identifier that distinguishes it from other circuits. This helps in troubleshooting, maintenance, and load management. The numbering system typically follows these conventions:

- **Phase Identification:** For three-phase systems, live wires are labeled L1, L2, L3 (or U, V, W) according to the phase sequence, the neutral wire is labeled N, and the ground wire is labeled PE or color-coded yellow-green .
- **Main Circuit Numbering:** Large current-carrying circuits, such as those feeding motors or major appliances, are numbered sequentially or according to the panelboard assignment. For example, motor windings may be labeled U1, V1, W1 for incoming terminals and U2, V2, W2 for outgoing terminals .
- **Control Circuit Numbering:** Secondary or control circuits often follow a digital numbering method, starting from 1 and increasing along the current path. Multi-circuit groups are numbered continuously within functional modules, e.g., 101 → KM1 Coil → 102 for a contactor coil .
