

How to open the casing of a network cable or fiber optic cable



Summary of Content

Opening a network or fiber optic cable requires careful stripping of the outer jacket using specialized tools to avoid damaging the internal fibers or conductors.

Tools Needed

- Fiber optic stripper for removing the protective jacket without nicking the fiber core .
- Kevlar cutter to trim strength members inside fiber cables .
- Utility knife or cable jacket stripper for copper network cables.
- High-precision cleaver for fiber ends if splicing is required .
- Protective gloves and safety glasses to prevent injury from sharp fibers or tools.

Steps for Fiber Optic Cables

- Visual Inspection: Check the cable for visible damage or kinks before opening .
- Locate the Section to Open: Identify the area where the cable needs to be accessed or repaired.
- Cut the Outer Jacket: Use a fiber optic stripper or utility knife to carefully remove the outer jacket without cutting the fibers inside .
- Trim Strength Members: Cut Kevlar or aramid fibers with a Kevlar cutter to expose the inner fibers .
