

How to pair single-fiber optical modules



Summary of Content

Single-fiber (BiDi) optical modules transmit and receive data simultaneously over one fiber using complementary wavelengths, and must always be deployed in matched pairs.

Understanding Single-Fiber (BiDi) Modules

A single-fiber SFP, also called a BiDi SFP, enables bidirectional communication over a single strand of single-mode fiber by using wavelength division multiplexing (WDM). One module transmits on one wavelength (e.g., 1310 nm) and receives on another (e.g., 1550 nm), while the module at the other end uses the opposite configuration. This allows full-duplex communication without requiring a second fiber, reducing fiber usage and deployment costs .

Deployment Steps

- **Select Matched Modules:** Ensure you have a pair of BiDi SFPs with complementary wavelengths. For example, if one module transmits at 1310 nm and receives at 1550 nm, the other must transmit at 1550 nm and receive at 1310 nm .
- **Insert Modules into Devices:** Plug each SFP module into the SFP port of the network devices (switches, routers, or media converters). These modules are hot-swappable, so devices do not need to be powered down .
- **Connect the Fiber:** Use a single-mode LC simplex patch cord to connect the two modules. Only one fiber strand is needed, as both transmit and receive signals share the same fiber .
