

How to run cables through multi-layer cable trays

Properly running cables through multi-layer cable trays requires careful planning, correct spacing, adherence to fill rules, and organized cable arrangement to ensure safety, prevent overheating, and maintain system reliability.

Planning and Preparation

Before installation, verify cable types, sizes, and load requirements to ensure compatibility with the tray system and compliance with design standards (). Check the tray for structural integrity, correct supports, and alignment. Multi-layer trays should be designed to accommodate the total cable load without exceeding the tray's fill capacity, typically not exceeding 40% of tray cross-section for safe heat dissipation ().

Layering and Spacing

- Separate cables by type and function: Power, control, and signal cables should be segregated to reduce electromagnetic interference and maintain performance ().
- Maintain proper spacing: Use dividers or cable ties to keep cables organized and prevent sagging. Ladder trays allow better ventilation, while solid-bottom trays require stricter fill limits due to heat buildup ().
- Respect minimum bend radius: Avoid sharp bends at tray entry and exit points to prevent insulation damage ().
