- **Attachment:** Secure the base of the fixing to a stable surface using screws, anchors, or adhesive, following the manufacturer's instructions. For walls or ceilings, drill pilot holes to ensure a firm hold .
- **Cable Placement:** Insert the cable into the slot, loop, or coil of the pigtail fixing without overstuffing. Overcrowding can damage insulation and reduce performance .
- **Tension Management:** Avoid pulling cables too tightly. Leave a slight slack to accommodate thermal expansion, vibration, or movement, which reduces stress on connectors and prevents breakage.
