

How to split a 4-core optical cable

Methods to Split the Cable

1. Passive Splitting

Passive optical splitters divide the incoming light signal into multiple outputs without requiring power. They are ideal for local networks or FTTH setups. For a four-core cable, you can use a 1x2 or 1x4 splitter depending on how many devices you want to connect . Steps:

- Identify the split point in the network and power down the system .
- Strip the outer jacket and buffer coating carefully using a fiber optic stripper to expose the cores .
