

How to stretch an independent optical cable

Stretching or extending a fiber optic cable must be done carefully to avoid exceeding its mechanical limits, which can weaken the fiber or degrade signal quality.

Understand Fiber Elongation and Tension Limits

Fiber optic cables have a defined elongation percentage, which is the maximum extension under stress that the cable can safely withstand. Exceeding this limit can create microcracks, weaken the fiber, or even break it, leading to signal loss or failure . Two key indicators are used:

- **Maximum Operating Tension (MOT):** The long-term tension the cable can safely handle, typically less than 0.2% elongation relative to its idle state .
- **Maximum Allowable Tension (MAT):** The short-term tension the cable can withstand during events like storms or snow loads .

Use Proper Pulling Techniques

When stretching a fiber optic cable:

- Pull by the strength member, not the outer jacket. The internal Kevlar or aramid yarn provides the cable's tensile strength, while the outer jacket can stretch or tear if used for pulling .
- Expose the strength member by carefully stripping a small portion of the jacket, then loop it through a pull-eye and secure it with tape or knots .
