

How to suspend fiber optic cables overhead



Summary of Content

Overhead fiber optic cables are suspended using poles or support structures with proper hardware, tensioning, and cable type selection to ensure durability and safety.

Planning and Preparation

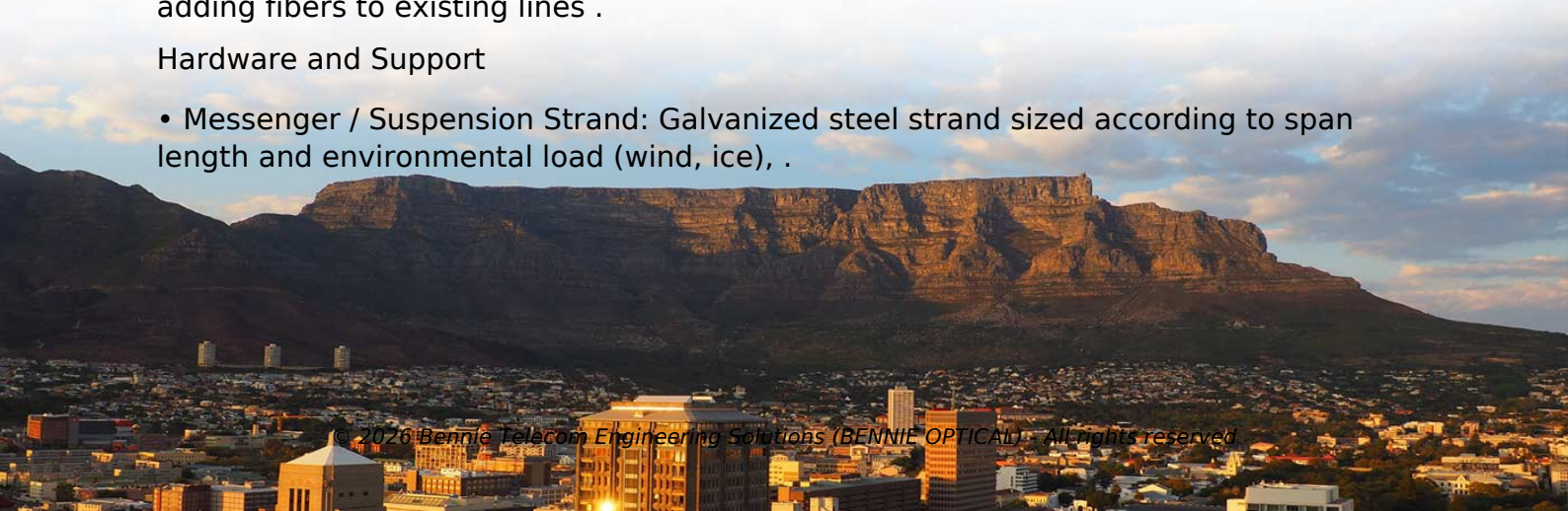
Before installation, survey the route to determine pole locations, clearances, and environmental conditions. Obtain permits from local authorities and coordinate with utility companies if sharing poles. Ensure all materials, including cables, messenger strands, and hardware, are procured and inspected for compliance with industry standards such as Telcordia GR-20 and ITU-T G.652 .

Cable Types

- ADSS (All-Dielectric Self-Supporting): Non-metallic, carries its own weight, suitable near power lines due to electrical isolation .
- Figure-8 / Self-Supporting: Integrated steel messenger in a figure-eight cross-section, simple to hang, rated for specific span lengths .
- Lashed Cables: Fiber cable lashed to a pre-installed messenger strand, flexible for adding fibers to existing lines .

Hardware and Support

- Messenger / Suspension Strand: Galvanized steel strand sized according to span length and environmental load (wind, ice), .
