

How to tie a butterfly-shaped optical cable

Understanding Butterfly Optical Cables

Butterfly-shaped optical cables, also called ribbon fiber optic cables, have a flat, symmetrical design with multiple fibers in a single ribbon. This structure allows for compact routing along walls, conduits, or window frames and supports tight bends without signal loss, especially when using G.657A1 or G.657A2 single-mode fibers . The flat design resembles a butterfly, with two “wings” flanking the central fiber unit .

Connection Methods

- **Fusion Splicing** Fusion splicing involves stripping the protective coating from the fiber ends, aligning them precisely, and using a fusion splicing machine to weld the fibers together with an electric arc. This creates a permanent, low-loss connection ideal for long-term installations .
- **Ribbon Splicing** Ribbon splicing is a variation of fusion splicing where the entire fiber ribbon is aligned and fused at once. This method is efficient for high-density applications, such as data centers, and allows multiple fibers to be connected simultaneously .
