

How to use the same fiber optic cable to connect two routers

Using a Secondary Router for Network Extension

The most common method is to connect the second router to the first router rather than directly to the fiber modem (ONT). Here's how:

- **Primary Router Setup:** Connect your fiber modem (ONT) to the WAN port of the primary router and configure it with your ISP settings to provide internet access.
- **Secondary Router Connection:** Use an Ethernet cable to connect a LAN port on the primary router to the WAN or LAN port of the secondary router.
- **Router Mode Configuration:** Set the secondary router to Access Point (AP) mode or Bridge mode to avoid double NAT issues. If AP mode is unavailable, leaving it in router mode is possible but may create network complications.
- **IP Addressing:** Assign a static IP to the secondary router within the same subnet as the primary router to prevent conflicts.
- **Wi-Fi Optimization:** Configure different SSIDs or channels for each router to reduce interference and improve coverage. Place the secondary router where the primary signal is strong but not obstructed by walls or appliances .
