

How wide should the cable tray hanger be

Standard Cable Tray Widths

Cable trays come in standard nominal inside widths ranging from small control circuits to large power or solar DC trunk runs. Common widths include 100mm, 150mm, 200mm, 300mm, 400mm, 500mm, and 600mm, with the outside width slightly larger due to side rail thickness. The tray width determines cable capacity, airflow, and ease of installation, and it directly influences the required hanger width.

Selecting Hanger Width

- Hanger width should match the tray width: The hanger must support the tray along its side rails without causing bending or deflection. For example, a 300mm wide tray typically requires a hanger that spans the tray's side rails, often slightly wider than 300mm to accommodate installation tolerances.
- Material and load considerations: Heavier trays or those carrying high cable loads may require reinforced hangers or wider brackets to prevent sagging. Ladder-type trays, which support heavy cables and long spans, often need hangers with additional width or cross-bracing.
