

Huawei switches use fiber optic stacking

Huawei switches support fiber optic stacking through dedicated service ports or stack cards, enabling multiple switches to operate as a single logical device for simplified management and increased bandwidth.

Supported Switch Models

Not all Huawei S series switches support stacking. For fiber optic stacking:

- S2700, S2720, S2750, S3700, S5700, and S6700 series generally support stacking, but some specific models are excluded (e.g., S2700-9TP-EI-AC, S5700-26X-SI-12S-AC).
- S1700 series switches do not support stacking.
- Always verify the specific model's datasheet to confirm stack support and the type of stack ports available.

Stack Port Types and Fiber Optic Connections

Huawei switches allow stacking via:

- Dedicated stack cables (zero-configuration stacking): These are pre-certified cables, often using QSFP or SFP+ fiber modules, providing high-speed, low-latency connections between stack members.
- Service port stacking: Uses existing fiber optic ports configured as stack ports. This method may require manual configuration to designate which ports participate in the stack. Important: Ordinary uplink ports can sometimes be used for stacking, but dedicated stack ports are recommended for reliability and performance.
