Residential Installation

It is important to leave sufficient clearance around the box for ventilation and future inspections, which helps prevent overheating and facilitates safe maintenance .

NEC Code Compliance

According to the National Electrical Code (NEC 2023), panelboards and distribution boxes must be installed in readily accessible areas. Key height and clearance requirements include:

- Mounting height: Not higher than 2 meters (6 ft 7 in) from the floor .
