

# Installation Method of Glass Cable Tray Support



## Summary of Content

Glass cable trays (GRP) can be installed efficiently by following proper planning, support spacing, cutting, joining, and safety practices to ensure a durable and low-maintenance cable management system.

### Planning and Preparation

Before installation, plan the tray route carefully, considering cable types, load, clearance, and future expansion. Mark the path using chalk lines or laser levels to ensure alignment and avoid interference with other systems. Choose the appropriate tray type (ladder, perforated, or solid-bottom) based on airflow, load, and environmental conditions, such as indoor, outdoor, or corrosive atmospheres .

### Tools and Materials

Essential tools include a power drill, hacksaw or angle grinder, measuring tape, level, and file for deburring. Materials include GRP trays, couplers, mounting brackets, threaded rods, anchor bolts, and grounding straps. Personal protective equipment (PPE) such as gloves, safety glasses, and a hard hat is mandatory .

### Cutting, Drilling, and Handling

GRP trays are lightweight but require careful handling. Cut trays with a fine-toothed saw or angle grinder and drill holes for supports as needed. No post-cut treatments are typically required. Avoid excessive force to prevent cracking, and always follow manufacturer guidelines for thermal expansion and joining sections .
