Maintain a height of approximately 1.5 meters for ease of access and ensure clearance around the box—typically 3 feet in front and 30 inches on each side—to allow safe operation and maintenance . Avoid proximity to water, flammable, explosive, or corrosive substances . If necessary, add a rain cover, cooling fan, or dehumidifier to protect against environmental factors .
