

Installation dimensions of secondary distribution box



Summary of Content

Secondary distribution boxes typically require enclosures sized to accommodate electrical components, with installation heights around 1.5 meters for residential use and larger dimensions for industrial applications.

Typical Enclosure Dimensions

Secondary distribution boxes come in various sizes depending on load capacity and application:

- Residential boxes: Usually compact, designed for lighter loads, with approximate dimensions ranging from 300-600 mm width, 400-800 mm height, and 150-300 mm depth .
- Commercial/industrial boxes: Larger enclosures to house multiple breakers, fuses, and protective devices, often 600-1200 mm width, 800-2000 mm height, and 300-600 mm depth .
- Concrete or precast enclosures: Used for outdoor or vehicular traffic areas, dimensions are standardized to meet structural and safety requirements, with covers and bodies labeled for identification .

Installation Height and Clearance

- Residential installations: Recommended height is approximately 1.5 meters from the floor, ensuring accessibility while keeping it out of reach of children .
