- **Clearance and Workspace:** Maintain a minimum working space height of 6.5 feet or the height of the equipment, whichever is greater, and ensure no equipment or storage obstructs access.
- **Moisture Protection:** Raise ground-mounted boxes 2-4 inches above the floor to prevent moisture damage.
