

Installation of Explosion-proof Distribution Box Panel



Summary of Content

Install the panel by securely mounting the enclosure, connecting certified explosion-proof cables to the terminals, properly grounding the box, and sealing all covers according to safety standards.

Preparation and Safety

Before installation, ensure the power supply is completely turned off to prevent electrical hazards or sparks (IEC, NEC, or local regulations) . Only qualified personnel should perform the installation. Verify that all cables, connectors, and components are rated for hazardous areas (EX or ATEX certified) and resistant to flame, impact, and mechanical damage .

Mounting the Enclosure

- Select a secure location that provides strength and rigidity to support the panel and internal wiring. Avoid areas prone to collisions, heat, moisture, or corrosion .
- Mount the enclosure using appropriate fasteners, ensuring the installation inclination does not exceed 5 degrees .
- If outdoors, fit a rain cover to prevent water ingress and rust .

Wiring the Panel

- Open the terminal chamber cover and route the incoming and outgoing cables through certified cable glands .
