Regulatory Compliance

In Georgia, low-voltage electrical installations must adhere to the Georgia State Minimum Standard Electrical Code, which incorporates the National Electrical Code (NEC) 2020 with Georgia-specific amendments . Low-voltage systems, such as telecommunications, data, and AC distribution boxes, may have less stringent requirements than high-voltage systems, but proper grounding, protection, and safety measures are mandatory . Licensed low-voltage contractors must be used for installation, and applications, renewals, or complaints are managed by the Georgia State Board of Low Voltage Contractors .

Distribution Box Selection

A low-voltage AC distribution box, also called a distribution board or load center, safely distributes incoming power to multiple circuits using MCBs, RCDs, RCBOs, fuses, busbars, neutral bars, and surge protective devices . Key selection criteria include:

- Application type: residential, commercial, industrial, or outdoor.
- Supply system: single-phase or three-phase AC, TN, TT, or IT earthing system.
- Number of outgoing circuits: include spare ways for future expansion.
