

Is APC a pigtail fiber

APC stands for Angled Physical Contact, a fiber connector polish type designed to minimize back reflection in optical networks.

What APC Means

In a fiber optic pigtail, APC refers to the polish style of the connector's end face, where the fiber tip is polished at an 8-degree angle rather than flat or slightly curved like PC or UPC connectors. This angled polish ensures that any reflected light is directed into the cladding rather than back into the core, significantly reducing return loss and improving signal quality.

Comparison with Other Connector Types

- PC (Physical Contact): Slightly curved end face, reduces air gaps, return loss around -40 dB.
- UPC (Ultra Physical Contact): More domed and tightly polished than PC, return loss around -50 dB, suitable for most digital and analog systems.
- APC (Angled Physical Contact): End face polished at an angle, return loss typically better than -60 dB, ideal for high-precision applications like FTTH, RF, and high-speed networks.
