Overview

Multimode MPO cables feature a larger fiber core (commonly 50 or 62.5 micrometers) that supports multiple propagation paths, or “modes,” for optical signals. Compared to earlier fiber optic types, it offers higher bandwidth and easily supports 40G, 100G, and even higher speeds. This is why it is commonly used in large buildings, server rooms, and data.
