This creates a metallurgical bond between the steel and zinc, forming a thick, durable coating that includes zinc-iron alloy layers for superior corrosion resistance . **Cold-Dip Galvanizing:** Involves applying a zinc-rich paint or spray containing 90-95% zinc powder directly onto the steel surface at room temperature. The coating forms a sacrificial barrier against corrosion but does not create a metallurgical bond . This method is simpler, faster, and suitable for field repairs, touch-ups, or components that cannot withstand high temperatures.

### Coating Thickness and Durability

- **Hot-Dip Galvanizing:** Produces a thicker coating, typically 5-10 mils (0.127-0.254 mm), offering long-term protection against corrosion, mechanical damage, and harsh environmental conditions. It is ideal for outdoor or industrial cable trays exposed to weathering .
- **Cold-Dip Galvanizing:** Produces a thinner coating, usually 1-2 mils (0.025-0.051 mm), which provides moderate corrosion protection. It is less durable than HDG and may require more frequent maintenance .
