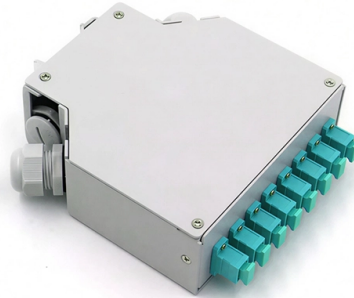


Latest Electrical Distribution Box Requirements

Placement and Accessibility

Distribution boxes should be installed in dry, well-ventilated, and easily accessible locations, typically at a height of around 1.5 meters for convenient operation and inspection. Wiring and Protection

Grounding and bonding must comply with the applicable earthing scheme (TT, TN, or IT) to prevent electric shocks and fire hazards. Advanced protection like Arc Fault Detection Devices (AFDDs) may be required in certain installations to reduce fire risk.
