Q2: What are typical span lengths for FRP cable trays?

Span lengths: Light loads (under 50 kg/m): 3-4m spans, Medium (50-100 kg/m): 2-3m, Heavy (100-200 kg/m): 1.5-2m, Very heavy (200+ kg/m): 1-1.5m. Always consider static and dynamic loads, maintaining deflection within. For fiberglass cable trays, proper span spacing ensures structural stability, prevents tray deflection, and maintains safe cable support throughout the installation. Specifying FRP cable tray correctly from the outset determines. Can be laid horizontally as in a cable channel with roof beams or vertically along walls_ or on structure. Can be supported on MS wall bracket or hanger. Our system is designed to fulfill the following standards' requirements: Thickness of FRP side rail.
