- Fault isolation to disconnect only the affected circuit during a short-circuit
- Organized distribution of power to multiple zones or fixtures Inside the box, circuits are often connected to MCBs (miniature circuit breakers), fuses, or terminal blocks, ensuring each lighting branch is protected and easily maintainable .
