Cleaning and Connector Care

Maintaining cleanliness is critical. Dust, oil, and static electricity can cause signal reflection, insertion loss, or connector corrosion. Use anti-static vacuums for floors and cable channels, and clean patch panels and connector ends with professional tools like fiber optic end-face cleaning pens or lint-free wipes. Avoid household tissues or cotton swabs, as they can leave fibers behind. Isopropyl alcohol (99% pure) is recommended for cleaning, followed by dry wiping to remove residue.
