- **Ladder Trays:** Prioritize width and side rail height for heavy power cables and long spans. Open rungs allow heat dissipation and airflow .
- **Perforated/Channel Trays:** Provide partial bottom support with ventilation; suitable for medium loads and control wiring .
- **Wire Mesh/Basket Trays:** Flexible and lightweight, ideal for data and telecom cables; load capacity depends on wire diameter and support spacing .

Fill Ratio and Expansion

- **Cable Fill Ratio:** NEC recommends 40% for power cables and 50% for control cables to prevent overheating and allow airflow .
