- **Fusion Splicing** Fusion splicing involves stripping the protective coatings from the fiber ends, aligning them precisely, and fusing them using an electric arc or laser. This creates a permanent, low-loss connection suitable for high-density applications. Fusion splicing is highly reliable but requires specialized equipment and trained technicians .
