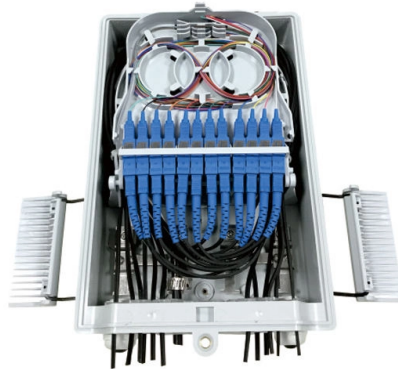


Method for splicing optical fiber optic junction boxes in the same direction

A capillary tube splice aligns the optical fibers inside of a glass tube, connecting them with a simple adhesive that matches the refractive index of the fibers. This setup allows for manual adjustments and is often a component in the more complex rotary splice. It also touches on emerging developments such as AI-assisted splicing tools and.
