

Monitoring 2 ports of a PoE switch



Summary of Content

You can monitor two PoE switch ports by using the switch's management interface to view real-time power consumption, port status, and PoE allocation.

Understanding PoE Monitoring

PoE monitoring allows a switch to track the real-time power consumption of each connected device. Managed switches can report the current, peak, and allocated power for each port, helping ensure devices like IP cameras, VoIP phones, or access points receive sufficient power without exceeding the switch's total PoE budget . Monitoring can also include alerts if a device draws more power than allocated, with options to log events or blink port LEDs to indicate issues .

Steps to Monitor Specific Ports

- Access the Switch Management Interface
- For Cisco switches, use the web GUI, CLI, or SNMP to access PoE statistics .
- For Aruba switches, navigate to the PoE tab in the switch dashboard under LAN > PoE to view port-level details .
- Locate the Ports
- Identify the two ports you want to monitor by port number or name.
- In the dashboard, you can drill down to see port status, PoE state (Enabled/Disabled), power class, priority, and current power usage .
- Enable Power Monitoring (if needed)
- Some switches require enabling PoE monitoring or power policing to track consumption accurately .
