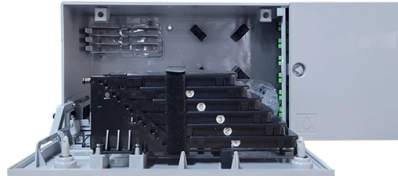


Mozambique Fiber Optic Communication
