

National Standard Level 3 Distribution Box Enclosure



Summary of Content

Level 3 distribution box enclosures must comply with NEMA and NEC standards, ensuring proper protection, accessibility, and internal layout for safe power distribution.

Enclosure Type and Protection

Level 3 distribution boxes are typically low-voltage enclosures designed to safely distribute incoming power to multiple circuits through devices such as MCBs, RCDs, RCBOs, fuses, isolators, and surge protective devices . The enclosure must provide protection against environmental hazards and personnel contact with live parts. Common NEMA types applicable include:

- Type 1: Indoor use, protection against solid objects and limited personnel contact .
- Type 3R: Indoor/outdoor use, protection against rain, sleet, snow, and ice formation .
- Type 4/4X: Indoor/outdoor use, protection against water ingress, splashing, hose-directed water, and corrosion (4X adds corrosion resistance), .
- Type 12: Indoor use, protection against dust, circulating particles, and light splashing . The IP rating may also be specified depending on the installation environment, ensuring dust and water ingress protection.
