Overview

The East Micronesian Cable Project is a 4 year project that commenced early in 2022, with an expected connectivity to the East Micronesian communities of Kosrae (FSM), Nauru and Kiribati in December 2025. Cable landing stations will be constructed at landing points in each country to facilitate connection to the main cable. This historic. Japan-US-Australia partnership plan to lay submarine cables to three Pacific Island Countries (Federate States of Micronesia, Nauru and Kiribati). The submarine cable, which is already connected from Guam to Pohnpei in Micronesia, will be extended to Kosrae in Micronesia, and then to Tarawa, the.
