Standard racks are typically 19 inches wide, with heights ranging from 48 to 83 inches, and vertical spacing measured in rack units (U), where 1U equals 1.75 inches. This standardization allows devices from different manufacturers to fit seamlessly within the rack ().

- Front and rear views: Front view for device placement, rear view for cabling and power planning ().
- Device grouping: Place similar devices together, e.g., switches near patch panels for shorter cable runs.
- Rack unit allocation: Assign U heights for each device, ensuring enough space for airflow and future expansion ().
- Power distribution: Include PDUs and UPS systems strategically to balance load and maintain redundancy ().
