Each fiber consists of a core that carries light, surrounded by cladding to prevent signal loss, and protective layers such as acrylic coatings, Kevlar fibers, and an outer jacket for durability . Fiber networks are widely used in internet, broadband, telecommunications, and high-performance networking environments .

Types of Fiber Optic Cables

- Single-Mode Fiber (SMF)
- Has a small core (~9 microns) and supports a single light path.
- Ideal for long-distance, high-speed transmission (up to 50 km or more).
