Common Causes

- **Disconnected or Loose Live Wire:** The incoming live wire (typically brown or red) may not be properly connected to the main terminal or circuit breaker .
- **Tripped or Faulty Breaker:** Check that the main breaker and individual circuit breakers are in the ON position. A tripped breaker can prevent live voltage from reaching the box .
- **Damaged or Cut Cable:** Inspect the incoming power cable for visible damage or breaks. Replace any damaged wires .
- **Voltage Drop or Insufficient Supply:** Long cable runs or undersized wires can cause a voltage drop, resulting in no detectable live voltage at the box .
- **Incorrect Wiring:** Ensure that the live wire is connected to the line terminal of the breaker, and the neutral wire is connected to the neutral busbar. For 2P breakers, both live and neutral must be correctly installed.
