An Optical Line Terminal (OLT) is the service provider endpoint in a Passive Optical Network (PON). It performs two main functions: converting electrical signals from the provider's network into optical signals for fiber distribution, and coordinating multiplexing with Optical Network Terminals (ONTs) or Units (ONUs) at subscriber sites . OLTs can support various PON standards, including GPON, XGS-PON, 10G-EPON, and combo-PON, allowing operators to serve multiple users over a single fiber infrastructure .

DML-Based OLT Modules

Directly Modulated Laser (DML) OLT modules are widely used in GPON and combo-PON applications. For example, the Semtech GN25L80B integrates a 2.5 Gbps DML driver with a 1.25 Gbps burst mode limiting amplifier, enabling high-speed, reliable optical transmission for GPON networks . These modules provide:

- Dual-loop extinction ratio control and eye-shaping for signal integrity
- Burst mode limiting amplifier to meet ITU Multi-PON Class D timing and sensitivity
- Combo-PON support, allowing GPON, XGS-PON, and HS-PON within the same SFP-DD module This makes DML-based OLTs ideal for network upgrades and multi-standard deployments, supporting both 1G and 10G networks simultaneously .
