Overview

Optical modules can have from a single channel up to 8 or more channels per transceiver, with high-speed modules using multiple parallel channels or wavelength-division multiplexing to increase total data throughput.

Typical Channel Configurations

- Single-channel modules: The simplest optical transceivers use one laser and one receiver, forming a single optical channel for data transmission .
- Multi-channel modules: Common in high-speed transceivers, such as QSFP-DD 400G modules, which often contain 8 parallel channels operating at 50G PAM4 each, or 4 channels at 100G PAM4 after DSP aggregation . Each channel typically requires a separate optical fiber unless wavelength-division multiplexing (WDM) is used.

Wavelength-Division Multiplexing (WDM)

- CWDM/DWDM modules: Multiple wavelengths are combined on a single fiber to increase channel count without adding fibers. For example, DWDM systems can support 40 to 80 channels in the C-band, with 50 GHz or 100 GHz spacing .
