

Number of circuits in the distribution box and spare circuits

The number of circuits in a distribution box depends on the panel's design, the type of breakers used, and the load requirements, with spare circuits left for future expansion.

Determining the Number of Circuits

A distribution box, also called a consumer unit or load center, contains multiple circuit breakers that protect individual circuits in a building. To determine the number of circuits:

- Count the breakers: Each single-pole breaker typically represents one 120V circuit, while a double-pole breaker represents a 240V circuit occupying two positions in the panel .
- Include 3-phase circuits: In commercial or industrial panels, triple-width breakers for 3-phase circuits must also be counted .
- Ignore main switches and RCDs: The main breaker and separate RCDs are not counted as individual circuits . Panels are rated by spaces (slots for breakers) and circuits (actual number of breakers installed). For example, a 40-space panel may support 40 circuits with standard breakers or up to 60 circuits using tandem or space-saver breakers, depending on the panel design and busbar capacity .
