The number of secondary distribution boxes is determined by the total electrical load, the number of circuits required, and the layout of the building or facility.

Understanding Secondary Distribution Boxes

A secondary distribution box (SDB) receives power from the main distribution box and distributes it to branch circuits within a building or floor . It acts as a local hub for electrical distribution, providing protection through circuit breakers or fuses and enabling isolation for maintenance or emergencies . Unlike the primary distribution box, which serves as the main power source, secondary boxes are installed closer to the load centers, such as individual floors, wings, or high-demand areas .

Steps to Determine the Number of Secondary Distribution Boxes

- **Calculate Total Electrical Load** Determine the total connected load for the building or area, including lighting, HVAC, appliances, and specialized equipment. Use the apparent power (VA) or real power (Watts) and consider the power factor for accurate sizing .
- **Identify Circuit Requirements** List all branch circuits needed, including dedicated circuits for high-demand equipment. Each circuit typically requires one protective device (MCB or fuse) in the distribution box .
- **Select Distribution Box Capacity** Choose the appropriate distribution board based on the number of ways (slots for protective devices). For example, a 12-way board can handle 12 circuits, while a 24-way board can handle 24 circuits . Include spare ways for future expansion.
