

ODF Fiber Optic Wiring Sequence



Summary of Content

ODF fiber optic wiring follows standardized color-coded sequences to ensure proper identification and connectivity across splice trays and patch panels.

Standard Fiber Color Coding

In most ODF installations, fibers are arranged in bundles of 12 or 24, with each fiber assigned a specific color according to international standards (TIA/EIA-598, ISO/IEC 60304, DIN 47200) . The typical 12-fiber sequence is:

Fiber Number	Color
1	Blue
2	Orange
3	Green
4	Brown
5	Slate
6	White
7	Red
8	Black
9	Yellow
10	Violet
11	Rose
12	Aqua

For 24-fiber cables, the sequence repeats in the same order for the second group of 12 fibers, often with a stripe or marking to differentiate the second set.

ODF Wiring Sequence Guidelines

- Cable Entry and Breakout
- Cables enter the ODF from the top or bottom via ducts or microducts.
- The outer sheath is stripped, and individual fibers are routed into splice trays .
- Splice Tray Organization
- Fibers are fusion-spliced to pigtails in the tray.
- Maintain the minimum bend radius to prevent signal loss.
- Fibers are arranged sequentially according to the color-coded table above.
- Patch Panel Termination
- Pigtails are terminated on adapters (SC, LC, ST, FC) in the patch panel.
