OLT Overview

An Optical Line Terminal (OLT) is the central device in a Passive Optical Network (PON), acting as the interface between the service provider's core network and the subscriber access network. It manages downstream and upstream traffic, allocates bandwidth, and coordinates communication with multiple ONUs/ONTs through optical splitters. Typically, an OLT connects to ONUs/ONTs via a passive optical splitter, forming a point-to-multipoint topology.

Direct Connection to an Optical Switch

In some network designs, an OLT can be connected directly to an optical switch (or aggregation switch) instead of using a traditional splitter for upstream aggregation. This setup is common in scenarios such as:

- Metro or access network aggregation: The OLT uplink ports connect to an optical switch to transport aggregated traffic to the core network.
- Short-distance deployments: When the distance between the OLT and the switch is small, direct optical fiber connections can reduce latency and simplify the network.
