

Om3 Multimode Fiber Color

OM3 multimode fiber is typically identified by an aqua-colored jacket, distinguishing it from other multimode and single-mode fibers.

Jacket Color Identification

OM3 is a laser-optimized multimode fiber (LOMMF) designed for high-speed networks using VCSELs (Vertical-Cavity Surface-Emitting Lasers). Its outer jacket is standardized as aqua (hex: #00B6C1), which visually signals support for 10, 40, or 100 Gb/s over short distances, typically up to 300 meters at 10G Ethernet . This color coding helps technicians quickly differentiate OM3 from older multimode fibers:

- OM1: Orange jacket, 62.5/125 μm core, LED-optimized
- OM2: Gray jacket, 50/125 μm core, LED-optimized
- OM4: Aqua or sometimes violet jacket, higher bandwidth than OM3
- OM5: Lime green jacket, designed for Short Wave Division Multiplexing (SWDM) applications

Connector and Internal Fiber Color Coding

While the jacket color identifies the fiber type, connectors and strain relief boots are also color-coded to maintain consistency:

- OM3 connectors typically use aqua-colored boots to match the jacket, ensuring easy identification and preventing misconnection with single-mode fibers (yellow) or APC connectors (green), .
